Recommended PAG oil: DENSO/ACCEL II

- P10 30000 PPT A2M (120 ml (4 fl.oz))
- P10 30000 PPT A2M (40 ml (1.3 fl.oz))

Get the recommended oil right at the amount listed if you replace any of the following parts:

- To avoid contamination, do not return the oil to the container once dispensed, and never mix with other refrigerant oils.
- Immediately after using the oil, reseal the cap on the container, and seal it's second moisture absorber.
- Do not spill the refrigerant oil at the vehicle, it may damage the paint. If it gets on the paint, wash it off immediately.

Condenser	35 ml (1.16 fl.oz, 1.2 Imp.oz)
Front evaporator	40 ml (1.35 fl.oz, 1.4 Imp.oz)
Rear evaporator	35 ml (1.16 fl.oz, 1.2 Imp.oz)
Line or hose	15 ml (0.51 fl.oz, 0.4 Imp.oz)
Leakage repair	25 ml (0.88 fl.oz, 0.9 Imp.oz)
Compressor	For compressor replacement, subtract the volume of oil drained from the removed compressor from A, and drain the calculated volume of oil from the new compressor. A: Volume of removed compressor + Volume of drain from new compressor. NOTE: Drain the oil in drain from the removed compressor. Don't drain more than 20 ml (0.71 fl.oz, 0.8 Imp.oz) from the new compressor.
