As soon as one group has two people, the remaining people are automatically assigned to the other group.

(c) Complete the table below by calculating the probability of each arrangement occurring if the sequential coin flip method is used.

Arrangement	A	B	C	D	E	F
Probability	$\frac{1}{16}$	$\frac{1}{8}$	$\frac{1}{8}$	$\frac{1}{4}$	$\frac{1}{8}$	$\frac{1}{8}$

$\frac{1}{16} + \frac{1}{8} + \frac{1}{8} + \frac{1}{4} + \frac{1}{8} + \frac{1}{8} = 1$
