**Sample Note-Taking and Summarizing: Prologue**

To help you keep track of the novel's events as they occur, you will be taking notes using a chart similar to the one below.

**Directions:** For each chapter, fill in the chart with the necessary information. An example for the Prologue is completed below. Write. Except when writing the summary, you do not need to write in complete sentences.

<b>Setting</b>	(A description of where the action occurs.) The summer of 1818 in Geneva, Switzerland, in a chateau.
<b>Characters</b>	List and describe important information about the characters in the chapter.) Mary Shelley, Percy Bysshe Shelley, and Lord Byron; Claire Clairmont, Lord Byron's mistress, and John Polidori were also present at the chateau that summer.
<b>Summary of the Chapter</b>	(A 3-5 sentence summary of the chapter.) Mary Shelley tells of how she came to write Frankenstein as a young girl. She tells of a group of friends engaged in a contest to see who could write the best ghost story. Shelley tells of her struggle to come up with a good story, and of how one night after a late night talk, she had a "waking dream" in which she saw overcome by the force of her imagination, she put her visions into paper, and thus began the tale of Frankenstein.
<b>Prediction of Coming Events</b>	(Write a prediction of what you think will occur in the next chapter.) The story of Frankenstein will begin, and we will learn what caused such horror in Shelley that fateful night.
