Wiring

1. Match each labeled wire with same letter on terminal.
2. Use a screwdriver to loosen screw terminals, insert bare wire into slots, then tighten screws.
3. Push any excess wire back into the wall opening.

Labels don't match?

If labels do not match letters on thermostat, see table below.

Existing wires	Connect to:
R • RH • 4 • V	Terminal "R" [1]
Rc	Terminal "Rc" [1]
O	Terminal "O" [2]
B	Terminal "B" [2]
G • F	Terminal "G"
W • W1 • H	Terminal "W"
Y • Y1 • M	Terminal "Y"
C • X • B	Do not use [3]



- [1] If wires will be connected to both R and Rc terminals, remove metal jumper.
- [2] Do not connect both O and B if you have a heat pump. Connect only the O wire. Wrap B wire with electrical tape and do not use.
- [3] Do not use C, X or B. Wrap bare end of wire with electrical tape.
- [4] If you have two wires, connect wires to R and W.
