1. When possible, jobs are designed to minimize manual material handling.					<input type="checkbox"/>	
2. When possible, mechanical lifting devices (forklifts, hoists, cranes, winches and trolleys) are used.					<input type="checkbox"/>	
3. Manual lifting and carrying devices (dollys, hand trucks, prybars, and hoists) are available and in good condition.					<input type="checkbox"/>	
4. Where possible, material and equipment are used that are easy to lift and carry (for example, bricks with handles) or fiber glass handling.					<input type="checkbox"/>	
5. Where possible, material and equipment are used that are easy to lift and carry (for example, bricks with handles or fiber glass handling).					<input type="checkbox"/>	
6. Where possible, material are ordered in small, light quantities (for example, 3 foot boards or small packages of material).					<input type="checkbox"/>	
7. Lifting tasks are divided among workers to reduce repetitive lifting.					<input type="checkbox"/>	
8. Heavy materials, which must be lifted should be stored off the ground, no more than knee height. (This covers the height of the lifting device and not the person on the ground).					<input type="checkbox"/>
