**Three-component Universal Remote**  
Congratulations on your purchase of this three-component universal remote. This universal remote controls up to three electronic components and makes regular remote controls a thing of the past. Your remote is programmed to work with all brands of equipment. This three-component universal remote is easy to use, easy to program and gives you control at the touch of one fingertip.

**SAVE THIS MANUAL AND THE CODE LIST!**  
Always consult our convenient code lists for programming when you change the battery. Make sure you keep the manual and code list in a safe place so that you can program the remote again when needed.

**Battery Installation and Information**  
This universal remote requires two AAA alkaline batteries (batteries may or may not be included, depending on model).

**Important Information:**  
1. Press and push the battery compartment cover to release it.  
2. Insert the batteries, matching the battery to the (+) and (-) inside inside the battery compartment.  
3. Push the battery cover back into place.

**Note:** If you are replacing batteries, be sure to press any button after you install the old battery set. Changing battery sets while entering a button code will result in an error tone for programming. The will not re-program the remote again.

**Battery Precautions:**  
• Do not mix old and new batteries.  
• Do not mix alkaline (standard carbon zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.  
• Always insert cells, used or new, in battery properly and push it down if they are unseated with your thumb and index finger.

**Battery Saver**  
Your universal remote cannot run on battery power for unreasonable hours off of any key is pressed for more than 30 seconds. This remote has a battery saver that should not prevent you from using the keys remote depressed, such as channel up/down.

**Programming Your Remote**  
Your universal remote can operate a variety of brands of components. In order for your universal remote to control your components, you need to program the remote with the codes that match the component (See Code List enclosed or go to www.rca.com/remote). There are codes for the remote to use with your components. You must first match the component to its own "language" and, by programming the remote code into your remote, you tell the remote to "speak the same language" as your component.

**Care and Maintenance**  
• Keep the remote dry. If it gets wet, clean it dry immediately.  
• Do not store the remote only in normal temperature environments.  
• Avoid use in areas with excessive humidity.  
• Keep the remote away from dust and dirt.  
• Keep the remote away from strong magnetic fields to avoid any locking tone.  
• Handling or programming with the remote's infrared components (infrared transmitter and receiver) may cause the remote to malfunction and deactivate its working.
