## Narrative Structure

1. **Orientation:** introduce setting and characters.
  2. **Complication:** create tension and interest by introducing a conflict or problem. Conflict may be inner or external (for main character(s)).
  3. **Development of complication:** gets worse/ consider options.
  4. **Climax or Crisis:** the most exciting part - the turning point or the moment the reader has been waiting for. Often involves a decision, realisation or new understanding/ epiphany.
  5. **Resolution:** conflict or problem resolved.
  6. **Evaluation:** summarise what has been learnt/ outcomes.
- Optional Ends to consider...
- Re-orientation:** conclusion may link to start, as in a cyclical plot.
- Twist:** may end with an unexpected twist or outcome.

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
