3. Federalist Party	Loyalty to a state rather than the whole country
4. Impresment	Each state decides for itself whether or not to allow slavery
5. Protective Tariff	Campaign against drinking, started by reformers in the 1820's
6. Monroe Doctrine	People who wanted to end slavery in the United States
7. Nullification	Period after the Civil War when the South was rebuilt
8. Manifest Destiny	Government agency that helped former slaves by providing food and clothing and tried to find free slaves jobs
9. Reformers	An act or decision that sets an example for others to follow
10. Abolitionists	The sum of money that is owed
11. Temperance Movements	Led by Alexander Hamilton and they drew their support from merchants, manufacturers and some southern planters
12. Women's Rights	Act of seizing men from a ship and forcing them to serve in the navy
13. Popular Sovereignty	Tax placed on imported goods to protect U.S. merchants and manufacturers from foreign competition
14. Sectionalism	Protected Latin America and Central America from European interference
15. Cotton Gin	Declaring a federal law illegal
16. Reconstruction	Belief that the U.S. had the right to all land between the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans
17. Freedman's Bureau	The struggle of women for equality and suffrage (the right to vote)
