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If you have already registered for the SOCRA CCRP exam, you should receive the SOCRA Certification Program Reference Manual in the mail. This manual is a good reference material. But imagine reading through the 21 CFR Parts 11, 50, 56, 312, 812, 45 CFR Part 46, and ICH GCP (E6) from start to finish; it can be quite grueling. By the end of it, how much information will you really get out of it? Also, the [SOCRA Certification Program Reference Manual](#) does not contain any industry experience from an industry insider whatsoever. It's just a printout of regulations, that's all it is.
